Chocolate poisoning can cause your pet to be sick, upset stomach, rapid breathing, an increased heart-rate and other symptoms can occur.

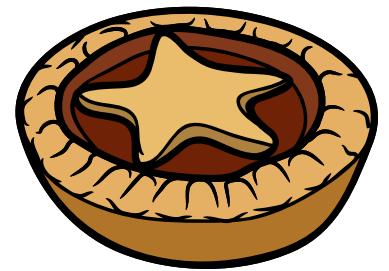


Christmas Pudding
