#### Why is this role important?

Volunteer drivers support the vital work of NAWT by assisting with transport, collections and drop offs of both donations and animals. Whether it's bringing a home direct animal to the centre for a visit or collecting furniture items to be sold at auction on behalf of the charity, there's always something our volunteer van drivers can do to support their local centre.

#### How you can support us

- Collecting or delivering large donation items such as furniture or animal enclosures within the local community.
- Transporting animals between the centre and the vets, their home or another rescue centre as required.
- Working within the Trust's Health and Safety Guidelines.
- This role will occasionally involve manual handling of heavy items.
